Individual contest will begin at 9:00. Open awards will be posted throughout the day and may be picked up at the awards table.

Pageant awards ceremony will be at the completion of the individual competition.

Team events will be after pageant awards followed by team awards ceremony.

- **Contestant lane assignments, team starting time and team line up will be emailed out the week of the contest.**
 - **No dress modeling. All pageant modeling will be in costume.**
 - **No interview for pageant modeling.**
- **Restrooms are available but no designated dressing rooms. Please feel free to bring changing tents etc. as there will be plenty of room available in a designated area for them.**
- **To avoid admission at the door, a \$20.00 gym fee will be added per each individual entry and \$30 for teams.**
- **Credit for entries paid for the 2020 contest that was canceled will be given. Please indicate on entry form that you wish to use your credit and how much in the space provided. If you are receiving a credit from last year, you still must complete an entry form by the deadline indicating that you have a credit and include the payment of the gym fee.**

Novice pageant contestants will compete in modeling , basic strut, and solo. Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced & College pageant contestants will compete in modeling, X-strut and solo. **SOLO DETERMINES YOUR DIVISION!** This pageant is open to all contestants, regardless of where they live. College division is open to girls who are furthering their education, either full or part-time, by attending a college, university, or a professional school. A collegiate twirler must complete and be able to show proof of enrollment or acceptance letter in order to be eligible to compete in that division.

AWARDS

- Awards for The Miss Octoberfest Pageant will be 1st-5th place trophies, except for Novice (Novice will receive plaques) and 1st-3rd place medallions in Modeling, Strut & Solo. Pageant winners will also receive a tiara and a sash.
- Open awards will be 1st & 2nd place medallions and 3rd-5th place medallions for Novice. All other divisions will be 1st & 2nd place trophies and 3rd-5th place medallions.
- Overall High Point award will be awarded for each age division.
- Team awards will be 1st-5th place trophies.

MUSIC

Each team director or a representative will be responsible for starting music for each of their teams. Sound system will be provided at the contest.

VIDEOS

Video taping will be permitted of **YOUR CHILD ONLY** for both teams and individual contests.

DIRECTIONS & PARKING

The easiest entrance to the North Exhibition Hall is the Quarrier Street entrance (across the street from Holiday Inn Express).
